Bresaola, anchovy and green olive paste, grissini, parmesan

Second course

Risotto, grilled radicchio, gorgonzola, pine nuts, currants

Pan roasted John Dory, parsley puree, fennel pickle, barberries, bacon bread

400gm grilled black angus grain fed T-Bone, ravigote dressing, grilled baby carrots

Third course

Milk chocolate tart, salted hazlenut praline, cherry sorbet
